- Milk & Juice Cartons
- Drink Boxes and Aseptic Containers
- Cardboard Boxes
- Cereal Boxes
- Gift Boxes
- Pizza Boxes

PLASTIC

- Water & Soda Bottles
- Milk Jugs
- Detergent Bottles
- All containers marked with a #1 – #7 (except Styrofoam)
- Plastic Grocery/Shopping Bags marked with a #2 or #4

METAL

- Tin Cans
- Aerosol Cans (empty)
- Aluminum Cans/Foil
- Pots & Pans

GLASS

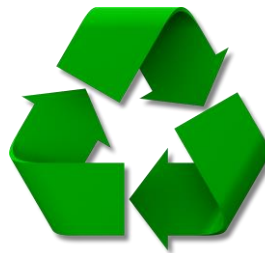
- All glass Bottles & Jars (all colors)

All containers should be empty

DON'T RECYCLE

- Batteries
- Bubble-wrap
- Clothes & Shoes
- Diapers
- Food (but you can compost it!)
- Kitty litter
- Knives
- Light bulbs
 - Incandescent (trash)
 - Compact fluorescent (return to store or save for hazardous waste day)
- Needles & Sharps
- Paper napkins
- Paper towels
- Plastic bags (bread, frozen food, snack & sandwich, garbage bags)
- Plastic wrap or film
- Potato chip bags
- Ribbon & bows
- Styrofoam® or polystyrene foam (even if marked #6)
- Packing peanuts (but they can be donated to a shipping company!)
- Trash
- Vinyl (siding, shower curtains)
- Waxed boxes & paper
- Wood
