

DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

Here in the City of Westbrook we love dogs – studies have shown that furry friends provide companionship, improve owner health and enhance quality of life. For all that our dogs do for us, it's important to take care of them as well. Dog license fees help support our local Animal Control Officer and State Humane Agents care for stray, injured or sick animals, return lost dogs to their owners, and to investigate animal cruelty complaints.

Per State Law, all dogs in the State of Maine must be licensed at 6 months of age or within 10 days of ownership. Dog licenses expire on December 31st each year and must be renewed on an annual basis by January 31st. It is a civil violation to own an unlicensed dog, which carries with it a court summons and a fine of up to \$100.

TO LICENSE YOUR DOG BY MAIL, PLEASE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- Copy of current rabies vaccination certificate
- Check or money order payable to "City of Westbrook"
 - \$6 for a spayed/neutered dog
 - \$11 for an unspayed/unneutered dog
 - \$25 late fee per dog (for renewals submitted after January 31st)
- Self-addressed stamped envelope
- The information outlined below
