
## STREET EXCAVATION PERMIT TRENCH PAVEMENT RESTORATION

### Description

**Pavement** – Paved trenches should be milled out at least 1 foot on either side of the trench and repaved with a minimum of 12.5 mm nominal aggregate sized hot mix asphalt. The ambient temperature should be 40°F and rising to ensure maximum compaction. Pavement should not be placed on top of pavement if it is wet, and gravel will not be paved on top of if puddling is occurring. The trench should have a minimum of 3 inches of pavement with each lift being no more than 1.5 inches in depth.

**Aggregate** – Aggregate should be put in a maximum of 8 inch lifts and compacted with a plate compactor or 5-ton roller.
