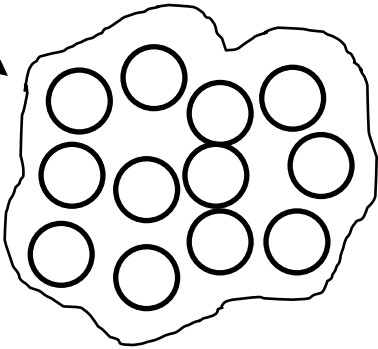


SUMMER READING LOG 2021

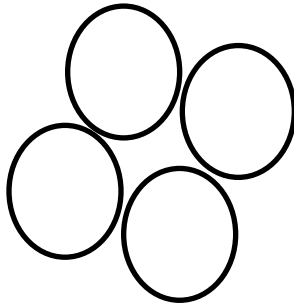

Wood Frogs normally lay 1000—3000 eggs in a large blob!

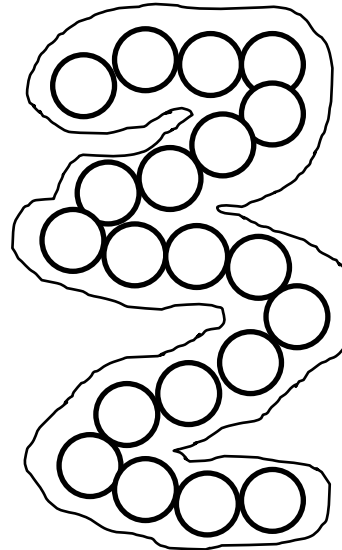
Once you have colored in all these eggs (15 minutes each), you will have done 3 hours of reading!

Snowy Owls lay 0—11 eggs depending on how much food is available.

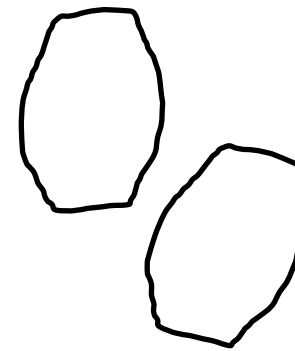
Color in all owl eggs and you've done 1 hour of reading!

American Toads lay 4000—12,000 eggs in a zig zag line!

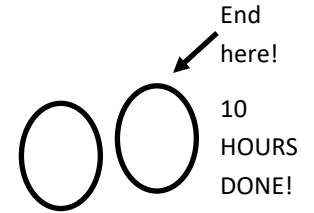
Color in the toad eggs for 5 hours of reading!



Zebra Shark

Zebra Sharks are one type of shark that lay eggs! They lay around 4 pod-shaped eggs at a time.

Platypus

A platypus is one of the very few mammals that lay eggs! They lay 1—2 at a time.
